Beauticians are in high demand in Australia. Growth is happening across all occupations in the beauty & personal care sector, with the largest spike projected for beauty therapists – with a 20% rise in demand projected by 2024

Vocational Education & Training Delivered to Secondary Students (VDSS):

Vocational Education and Training Delivered to Secondary Students (VDSS) allows secondary students to gain practical skills in a specific industry while undertaking the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) including the Vocational Major (VCE VM).

Our programs are taught by industry-experiencd practitioners in the latest training facilities, and include specialised excursion and workplace-learning components.

Programs are typically completed over two years and provide students with a qualification or partial completion of a nationally recognised certificate.

Casey College of Beauty Therapy has delivered accredited Beauty Therapy qualifications for more than 16 years in partnership with local salons for Melbourne's South East.

What are the benefits?

VDSS programs contribute directly to the VCE/VCE VM and can contribute towards the ATAR score.

Other advantages for students who take part in our program include:

- gaining real industry experience and employability skills
- creating a pathway to further study (certificate through to advanced diploma qualifications)
- opportunities to develop effective relationships with employers
- assists transition from school to work environment;
- enhancing knowledge of employer and workplace expectations
- developing the capacity for teamwork and leadership.

How to enrol:

To enrol into one of our VDSS programs you must be registered with a secondary school and enrolment into the program is negotiated through your school. ccbt qualifications and eligibility

Program duration & outcomes:

VDSS programs are run over two years, part time, generally requiring a half to one day a week commitment over the two school years. To complete a qualification you need to successfully complete all units of competency in the two years. If you don't successfully complete all units of competency in the program you will still receive a Statement of Attainment (SOA) which will list the units you have achieved.

Successfully completed units of competency can be used to apply for credit in future studies in the same area or simply add to your employability skills.

Eligibility:

Students can start in VDSS programs from Year 10 onwards. If you start a VDSS program in Year 10, it will be counted as one of your electives at school.

Most students undertake VDSS in their final two years of secondary studies. VDSS can be undertaken in both VCE and VCE VM streams. In VCE VM your study is broken into blocks. For every 90 hour block, you get one VCE VM unit credit.

In VCE your VDSS program can contribute in two ways:

- In our VDSS program, your studies will contribute through block credit recognition. If you
 undertake a VDSS program as part of your VCE, the VDSS program will contribute
 directly to your ATAR.
- In our VDSS program, your 3 and 4 sequence will contribute directly to your ATAR as one
 of your top 4 subjects or as a 5th/6th.

ccbt nitty gritty

Course requirements:

Each week of the program you will attend either half &/or day of work on campus. You will also have homework, some online studies, and revision to complete at home.

Being in an adult setting your trainers will expect you to demonstrate responsibility and a mature approach to your studies. You are required to meet a minimum of 90% attendance. As the programs are fast paced, missing classes will jeopardise your ability to enjoy the program and make progress as required.

Your program will consist of units of competency which means you will need to demonstrate that you have understood and mastered the skills expected. You will be assessed on your performance however it is not like an exam, instead it is an ongoing process.

Many of our programs are a great start to VET studies as the trainers you have in VDSS are the same trainers you will have if your continue to study with us after you leave school.

Our VDSS programs run on campuses that are aligned with the disciplines of study you are undertaking in Beauty at our campuses at Berwick, Cranbourne
